Tips for Long-Lasting Timber Floors:

Keep it clean Dirt and grit acts as abrasives which wears down the seal on your floor but regular cleaning will help preserve its beauty and integrity. For this, we recommend using good matting at entrances.

Prevent scratches Avoid dragging chairs, equipment, & small-wheel trolleys across the floor as these can cause damage to the surface.

Routine care Dust mop and wash the floors regularly to remove dust and grit to maintain your floor's shine, luster and performance.

Reinforce high-use areas Applying additional coats of seal in heavy-traffic zones will extend the floor's life.

Minimise your future costs by repairing your floor regularly

Over time, the seal on the floor naturally wears down through regular use. It is crucial to maintain an adequate seal on the floor to:

- **Protect the timber:** If the seal wears through to the timber, the timber will be exposed and may discolour in patches. The only way to rectify this is by re-sanding the floor.
- **Protect the line markings:** Once the seal wears away, the line markings are next to be affected.
- **Protecting the users:** As the seal wears away, the floor becomes more slippery, posing a risk to those using the venue.

We recommend applying one or two coats of seal every one or two years depending on the floor's usage.

Another important consideration is understanding your seal type, whether it is oil-based or water-based. This will determine the process and seal for additional coats, incorrect application can result in long-term damage.

When we perform your maintenance coat, we:

- Inspect your floor to check your floor's health. We look for any signs that may indicate larger problems such as signs of floor expansion due to a water leak.
- Thoroughly clean the floor, removing any gum, stickers, and scuff marks. These must be removed before applying the new coat of seal to avoid sealing them into the floor.
- Vacuum out the game posts, electrical boxes, expansion and ventilation gaps.
- Cover and protect any hardware installed next to the floor to prevent the seal from getting on them.
- Apply the new seal.

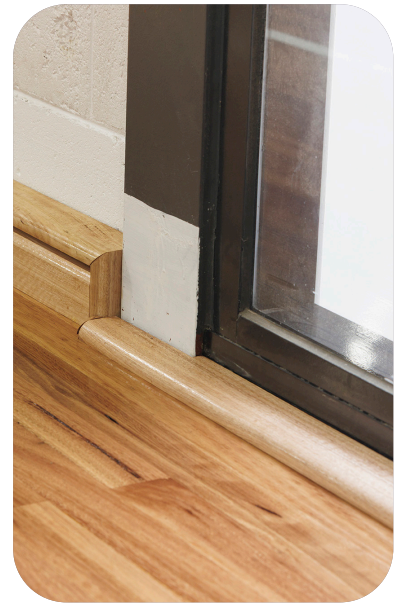


Regular cleaning is essential for the longevity of your timber

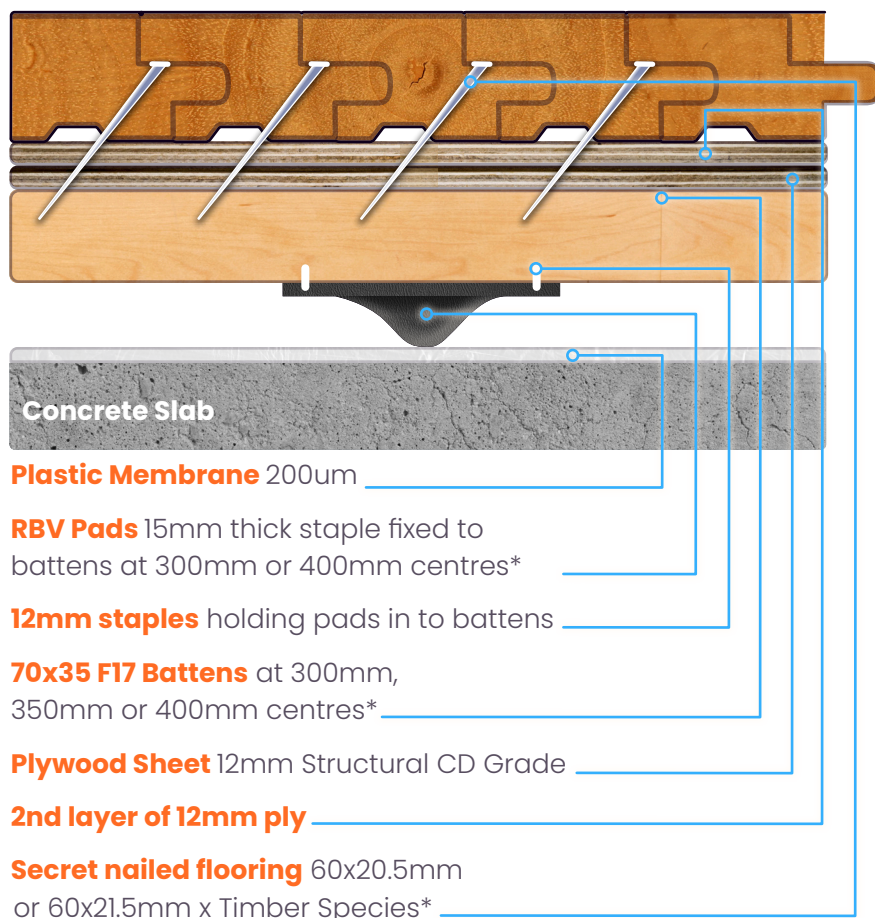
